

WHAT WE LOOK FOR IN AN APPLICANT

The admission process at High Meadows School seeks to determine if the school is the right "match" for the applying child and family. We look at applicants holistically and use many criteria to predict whether a child will be successful at High Meadows. We value diversity and welcome families of all races, colors, creeds, national origins, religions, and sexual orientations. Though making the right match is more art than science, below are the guidelines used by our admission committee to evaluate students and families for admission to High Meadows School.

Our Admission Committee reviews applications for demonstration of:

- Positive interactions with peers and teachers
- The ability to work both independently and collaboratively
- Natural curiosity and motivation
- Enthusiasm about the school environment
- Socially appropriate behavior
- The ability to adjust to transitions throughout the school day
- Self-regulation of body and behavior
- Respect for peers and learning
- As applicable, performance that is on or above grade level as evidenced by school transcripts, progress reports and any standardized tests that may have been taken
- Favorable assessments and comments on recommendation forms regarding both academic and social performance

The successful applicant's parents or guardians will...

- Show a propensity for embracing a child-centered, globally-focused, progressive approach to education
- Be supportive, realistic, patient and communicative
- Partner with the school to support student growth and learning
- Demonstrate a willingness to volunteer their time and talent in support of the school
- Understand the school's basic financial model and agree to participate in philanthropic giving to the best of their ability
- Understand and support the school's goals and initiatives around diversity, equity and inclusion



HOW TO APPLY

Application

We will begin accepting applications for the 2023-24 school year on October 1, 2022. Complete the online application for admission at www.highmeadows.org through our online application host, Ravenna Solutions.

Supplemental Forms

For grades 1-8, delegate the AAAIS Transcript Release Authorization and Teacher Evaluation Form(s) to your child's current school through your online Ravenna application account. For Pre-K applicants who have attended a previous school or daycare, please delegate the Teacher Evaluation Form to your child's current teacher or caregiver through your Ravenna application account.

Visit Us

Attend a High Meadows Open House, Family Farm to Forest event, or Campus Tour. You may register for all events through your Ravenna account online.

Classroom Visits and Assessment (Applicants to grades 1-8)

Applicants to grades 1-8 will attend a shadow day at High Meadows during which they will join a classroom of peers for a typical day of school, and for some grade levels, complete a brief academic assessment. Visit days will be held January-March 2023.

Pre-K and Kindergarten Play Assessments

Pre-K (age 3 and 4) and Kindergarten applicants participate in a brief Play Assessment. The Play Assessment is a chance for our teachers to observe your child's interactions, interests, and communication within a small group of peers. Once you have submitted your online application, we will contact you to schedule your Play Assessment date, which your child will attend in February or March 2023.

Parent Interview

As part of the application process, we like to sit down with parents/guardians to hear more about their family, their child, and what they are seeking in a school. Our goal is to enroll not only students who will benefit from and contribute to our school community, but also families who value our progressive school model and community. Most interviews will take place between December and February and are typically conducted via Microsoft Teams online meetings.

Our tuition is intentionally comprehensive and covers most annual expenses including school supplies. Grade level fees range by student age and primarily fund field trip and yearbook expenses.

AFFORDING HIGH MEADOWS SCHOOL

High Meadows offers need-based financial aid to qualified families with children in five-day Pre-K through Eighth Grade.

We utilize School and Student Services (SSS), a confidential third party, to process financial aid applications and help the financial aid committee to objectively assess a family's ability to contribute toward educational expenses. According to standard practice, all household income for all parents and guardians is considered when determining financial need.


